

PROVINCIA MIDNIGHT CUP

- Registration on tournament day **before the first game** is in Haparanda sportshall, A-hall/Folkets Hus (Åkergatan 1. 953 34 HAPARANDA, Sverige). Part of the games will be played in Aspen-sports hall. All final games are played in A-sports hall.
- Maximum of 11 players in one team. There are no license restrictions. If there's player injuries after the registration, **new players CAN NOT BE ADDED to the teams**, even if the max of players is not full. So fill the forms completely before the first game. If all the players can't make it to the first game on time, they will be marked to the team but they still have to do the registration when they arrive.
- **A player can only play in one team and only in one division. If there's rule violations the player will be removed from the team and the tournament. Also all the games played before violation will be refereed to 5-0 defeats (loss) of the violating players team.**
- **Remember! In the junior division (born 03-05) all players must have protecting glasses! You can play with eyeglasses but we are not responsible for refunding broken glasses. In adults divisions protective glasses are not mandatory but recommended.**
- **In junior divisions (born 03-05) all players must prove their age, so take your ID with you. In this division the whole team gets removed from the tournament if organizers find that there is an overaged player in the team. Tournament organizer is responsible for possible exceptions.**
- Using intoxicants is absolutely forbidden in this tournament! The organizers will breathalyze during the tournament. **Snus is also intoxicant! Rude rule violations or repeated unsportsmanlike behaviour will lead to whole team getting removed from the tournament!** And all the games played before violation will be refereed to 5-0 defeats (loss) of the rule violating team.
- Organizers and referees will always make the last decision about any issues or problems. General line is that there are no exceptions to the rules.
- During the tournament the referees word is the law. We recommend all the players to get to know the rules of floorball in advance. Referees will make judgements considering that this is an amateur tournament.
- If the team for some reason decides to stop their tournament and isn't going to play games that are left, they must immediately let the bookkeeper know. Rule violation in this case will have consequences.

- **Tag your personal belongings clearly to avoid losing or mixing them.** Teams will have shared locker rooms. The organizers are not responsible for property that's left in locker rooms.

- You can ask for your lost belongings from the sports halls afterwards. Organizers are not responsible for lost, broken or left belongings. At the Info-desk you can ask if it's possible to leave your valuables there for the tournament.
- There is a small cafe where you can buy small snacks, soda and coffee with cash, both euros and kronas. No card payments.

Games:

- Playing time: 1×12 min.
- Amount of players in the field at a time: 1+5
- Victory 3 points, tie 1 point
- Group shares will be announced as soon as we have all the teams signed up.
- In case of two teams with same amount of points the result will be played in following way:
 1. game between the teams
 2. goal difference (how many made, how many passed)
 3. lot
- Games that end in tie during the playoffs will be resolved by penalty shots, 3 shooters.
